# From The President



Dear credit union member.

If you found yourself in need of funds to cover one of life's unexpected events today, would you have it available? If not, you should consider starting an emergency fund. Whether it is an appliance replacement, major car

repair, visit to the ER or even unemployment, things happen, and you want to be prepared. Here's how to get started:

- Evaluate your current budget and spending to identify areas where you can pull funds from.
- Split a portion of your direct deposit paycheck into a separate savings account (or set up a recurring transfer from your checking) to make saving the funds an easy process.
- Begin with a small amount of savings each month and try to increase it whenever possible throughout the year.
- If you receive any additional money throughout the year - such as from a tax refund, bonus or special occasion - use it to boost your emergency savings.
- Plan to save at least \$1,000 at first, and then work your way up to cover 3-6 months' worth of expenses if possible.
- Consider a short-term CD to house your emergency funds so they are separate from your other accounts, but still quickly accessible when you need them.
