Eligibility Guidelines

Scholarship applicants must meet the following requirements:

- * Applicant must either be a member of North Georgia Credit Union or the child of a credit union member. For scholarship purposes, the term child is defined as a natural or adopted child or stepchild who is a dependent of a NGCU member. The applicant or parent/guardian must be a NGCU member in good standing prior to the application deadline.
- * Applicant must be a high school student in **Franklin**, **Hart**, **Rabun or Stephens County**. Applicant must be on schedule to graduate with or before his or her class.
- * Applicant must have at least a cumulative 3.0 GPA and have taken either the SAT or ACT.
- * Applicant must plan to enter an accredited university, college or technical college no later than the start of the upcoming Fall Semester.
- * Applicant must complete all fields (typed in fillable boxes), follow all instructions and comply with all dates/deadlines contained in this application form. Do not include any personal identification information anywhere on this form other than in the spaces where such information is requested.
